In 2012, Megan began to have a change of heart...thanks to Twitter! She zealously debated people on Twitter, but soon things changed. She said, in a TED talk,

One Minute Tech ~ from your IT Guy, Mike Moore

"We're not evolving fast enough; our bodies and minds are not fit for the new world we live in." is the manifesto of a new relaxation app called Endel and it is rapidly gaining widespread popularity across the globe. It features five modes of music themes that include Relax, Focus, On-the-Go, Sleep, and AI Lullaby. While not for everyone's musical taste the app provides a



unique experience for each user as it accesses various sensors in a mobile device's hardware. Independent validation tests showed that Endel is effective at increasing concentration and decreasing anxiety. It's AI powered soundscapes adapt in real-time to different mobile device personal inputs like location, weather, and heartrate. Endel also considers natures organic rhythms and cycles to complement how you feel during the night or day. It uses simple sounds that are both pleasant and psychologically natural. It was developed to use specially tuned noises to make distracting sounds and harsh interruptions less audible. The science behind Endel is quite fascinating and as a music lover, I found it very pleasant and refreshing to help ease into sleep and to gain focus for critical tasks like writing these One Minute Tech articles. Endel is available for both Android and Apple devices and integrates with Amazon's Alexa. While not free, there is a 1-week trial available that lets you get a feel for how the app can benefit you. A monthly subscription costs \$5.99 or a 1-year subscription can be purchased for \$29.99. If you do happen to try it out, I would love to hear what your thoughts are. Ah... Thanksgiving! Do you have any traditions that go along with the holiday? I love Traci Smith's *Gratitude Tree* idea.

Supplies: Construction/ Cardstock Paper, Scissors, Hole Punch, Markers/ Crayons/ Pencils, Yarn, Tree/ Bush with low hanging branches

What to do: Cut out paper circles, punch a hole in each circle, and make a loop of yarn to make ornaments.

Before your meal, ask everyone to write what they are thankful for on their ornament. Small children can draw instead of write. Have people hang them on the tree/ bush.

Before or after your meal, gather at the tree and take turns reading off the tree (don't evaluate what anyone writes, just accept them). 
Last Call for Simple Abundance Class:
