Tree is a great mobile app that lets you create your own digital calendar and share it with anyone you like. They can add their own schedules to the calendar so everyone knows who will be where and who has free time. How about a hobbies calendar or a calendar for vacation time? A family calendar lets you post family events, and everyone invited can see what is coming up and add comments or update the calendar. Time Tree is great for work teams who need a way to schedule availability and off time. The memo feature lets you add comments to the event and a reminder can be set so you never forget to be on time. Time Tree is free to use and the paid version removes Ads from the bottom of the screen. It is available for both Android and Apple devices and users can schedule calendar events even if their devices are different. Youth & Children's Ministry ~ Pastor Heather

I recently listened to a podcast from Rob Bell about boredom. While the podcast is from 2017, I found it still so powerful and true for today.



Think about all the times that you/ your kids / grandkids are in front of a screen. I find sometimes when I am in a drive through that is long and slow, I pick up my phone to scroll. Why!?!? We live in "screen-land" for productivity, to bust boredom, to entertain, etc.

Rob Bell was talking about how when we fill all the gaps in our day with a screen, that is all the times we are waiting a few minutes here and there, we no longer have the space to explore our soul. Our minds do not have the time to process the information around us, think about our day, reflect on conversations or events, pray and so on. While we are more connected to one another, we are less connected with ourselves and with God. We have no time to "be still and know that [God] is God." (Psalm 46:10)

As we move through the Christmas season, I challenge you to embrace the boredom and allow the gaps in your day to be just that, gaps and not fill them. When you pick up your phone, tablet, TV remote, whatever... ask yourself if you actually need it because you probably do not. Grown ups, challenge your kids to do the same and watch the beauty that comes from it (I know I am going to do this)


